The Passing of Mrs Joan Burlew OAM.

It is with much regret that I have to advise you of the passing of one of our most longserving and distinguished Brisbane Association Members - Mrs Joan Burlew OAM. Joan passed away peacefully at St Vincent's Hospital, Kangaroo Point, Brisbane on 3rd March 2021.

Joan joined our Brisbane Association many years ago, having served quite actively on our Management Committee and the Executive of the Coral Sea Commemorative Association, organizing and attending events even till the age of 95. As well, she served for many years as Australian President of the American Legion Auxiliary with honour and distinction. At the 2010 Australia Day Honours, Joan was awarded the Order of Australia Medal by the then Governor-General of Australia, Quentin Bryce, for service to the community through voluntary roles with church, health care and service organisations.

Joan was born on 6th September 1925, and you may recall an article appearing in our September 2020 Newsletter, where we wished her a very happy birthday on reaching the grand age of 95 years.
